Subject: Clarification of Summative ELPAC Examiner's Manuals for Grade Spans 3-5 and 6-8



Dear LEA ELPAC Coordinator:

It has come to our attention that there is a formatting error in the grades three through five and grades six through eight versions of the Summative English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC) *Test Examiner's Manuals*. Note the following edits to these publications:

- An error in the ***Grades 3–5 ELPAC Summative Examiner's Manual*** was identified.
 - In the middle of **page 46**, where it states: **RUBRIC FOR SPEAKING-SUPPORT AN OPINION, NUMBER 11**, NUMBER 11 in the rubric title is incorrect; please replace it with 10.
 - In the middle of **page 48**, where it states: **RUBRIC FOR SPEAKING-SUPPORT AN OPINION, NUMBER 10**, NUMBER 10 in the rubric title is incorrect; please replace it with 11.
 - Note: All information on the page is correct; just the rubric title numbers were reversed.
- On page 52 of the *Test Examiner's Manual* for **grades six through eight**, the claim in Speaking Item #12 should be bold, indicating that the test examiner should read the claim aloud for this item.
