Educational Testing Service (ETS) would like to provide you with additional guidance that will help you and your local educational agency successfully administer the 2018–19 Summative English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC).

As a result of revisions made to the [California Code of Regulations, Section 11518.25](#) and [Section 11518.30](#) that were approved by the State Board of Education on November 9, 2018, there are changes to the procedures for administering the 2018–19 Summative ELPAC.

The changes specifically impact Box 11—Alternate Assessment(s) and Box 12—Contractor-Directed (Domain Exemptions[s]). The instructional web document on the procedural changes for the [2018–19 Summative ELPAC Answer Book Boxes 11 and 12](#) is posted on the [Manuals and Instructions](#) web page on [elpac.org](#).

Alternate assessments, as determined appropriate by the individualized education program team (IEP), are to be administered only to students with the most significant cognitive disabilities and whose IEP team has designated the use of an alternate assessment.
