The administration of the 2019–20 Summative English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC) and the 2020–21 Initial ELPAC will be delivered using the same online test delivery system as CAASPP assessments. Education Testing Service is providing the [ELPAC and Alternate ELPAC Communication Toolkit](#) on the [ELPAC website](#) as a resource to help local educational agencies (LEAs) and test sites with outreach efforts to parents and guardians about the transition to the computer-based ELPAC and the Alternate ELPAC.
