Subject: ELPAC: Information on the K-2 Remote, Computer-based Administration for Reading Domains



Dear LEA ELPAC Coordinator:

Last week, local educational agencies (LEAs) were advised to delay remote, computer-based administration of the following assessments:

- Initial ELPAC kindergarten and grade one Reading domain
- Optional Summative ELPAC kindergarten Reading domain
- Optional Summative ELPAC grade one Reading domain for LEAs assigned to Form 4

The addenda to the *Directions for Administration (DFAs)* are now available to better support consistent remote administration of the *Read-Along Story with Scaffolding* test items. In the addenda, the instructions for items that ask students to identify the first word of a story or the direction in which the text should be read have been adapted for remote test administration.

The *DFA* addenda are available on the [ELPAC Administration and Scoring Moodle Training Site](#). You can obtain Moodle enrollment keys for Summative ELPAC Downloads and Computer-based Initial ELPAC Downloads by following these steps:

1. Visit the [ELPAC Administration and Scoring Training](#) website and log on with your access code.
2. Select the [**Summative Moodle Training Site**] or [**Initial Moodle Training Site**] button to obtain your respective enrollment keys.

Once you have secured a key, take the following steps to download the *DFA* addendum or addenda you need:

1. Log on to the [ELPAC Moodle Training Site](#).

For Summative ELPAC *DFAs*:

- a. Select the [2019–20 Computer-based Summative ELPAC Training Resources] link.
- b. Next, select the [Summative ELPAC Downloads] link.
 - i. Enter the enrollment key, if requested.

- c. Scroll down to the “DFA Remote Addendums” section to download one or more PDF file.

For Initial ELPAC *DFAs*:

- a. Select the [2020–2021 Computer-based Initial ELPAC Training Resources] link.
- b. Next, scroll down and select the [Computer-based Initial ELPAC Downloads] link.
 - i. Enter the enrollment key, if requested.
- c. Scroll down to the “DFA Remote Addendums” section to download one or more PDF file.
